
Hereinafter called the trustees which terms shall wherever the context so requires or permits, mean and include the trustees for the time being or their successors in office as trustees.

Whereas the author of the trust above mentioned has been desirous of creating and establishing a public charitable trust with the objects of general public utility enduring for the benefit of the public and whereas intending to give effect to the said desire has set apart a sum of Rs.1000/-(Rupees One Thousand only) for Public Charitable purposes and objects of General Public utility and has this day paid unto the trustees, the said sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only).

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Whereas the aforesaid trustees have agreed and accepted to be the first trustees of the trust and whereas the Author of the trust hereby transfers and pays a sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) bycash to have and to hold the same upon the trust for the objects described elaborately herein subject to the powers declared hereunder.

NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AND DECLARES ASFOLLOWS

The Name and address of the trust shall be ""TVR PUBLIC CHARITABLE TRUST" No. 31/133, New Street, Ayanavaram, Chennai-600023.

The Trust will start its functioning from the rental building of the abovesaid address. With its or at such other place or places as the trustees may decide upon from time to time.

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

OBJECTIVES

- a. To provide education opportunities for underprivileged children by establishing schools and scholarships, aiming to reduce illiteracy and improve future prospects.
- b. To provide nutritious food and support to elderly individuals, the homeless population, and children in need, with a focus on addressing food insecurity and promoting well-being among these vulnerable groups
- c. To support skill development programs for unemployed youth through vocational training and job placement, enhancing employability and reducing poverty.
- d. To establish educational institutions such as schools, colleges, technical institutions, and medical colleges to provide accessible education to underserved communities.








- e. To promote environmental conservation through awareness campaigns and projects, aiming to protect natural resources and mitigate climate change impacts.

- h. To raise awareness about the consequences of alcohol addiction within the community through educational campaigns, workshops, and outreach programs.

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




- To provide accessible and affordable rehabilitation services for individuals struggling with alcohol addiction, including counseling, detoxification, and long-term recovery support.
- j. To collaborate with health care professionals, social workers, and other relevant stake holders to ensure comprehensive and holistic care for individuals seeking rehabilitation from alcohol addiction.
- k. To advocate for policies and initiatives that promote prevention, early intervention, and effective treatment of alcohol addiction at local, regional, and national levels.
- To support the establishment of self-help groups for economic empowerment by providing training and financial assistance, promoting self-sufficiency and entrepreneurship.







- m. To provide shelter and care for home less and orphaned individuals by establishing shelters and orphanages, ensuring basic needs and protection.
- n. To promote youth welfare through mentoring and educational programs, fostering personal development and civic engagement.
- o. To support sustainable development projects in rural and urban areas by promoting eco-friendly practices and community development, ensuring long- term prosperity and environmental protection.
- p. To provide financial assistance for the elderly and promote their wellbeing through healthcare and social support, ensuring dignity and quality of life.
- q. To promote sports among under privileged youth by organizing tournaments and providing training facilities, fostering teamwork and physical well-being.

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- r. To provide vocational training and employment opportunities for marginalized communities by partnering with industries and providing skill development programs, reducing unemployment and poverty.
- s. To support initiatives for the welfare of children, including nutrition and education, ensuring a healthy and educated future generation.
- t. To promote renewable energy and eco-friendly practices by raising awareness and supporting green energy projects, mitigating environmental degradation.
- u. To provide microfinance and entrepreneurship opportunities for women by offering financial literacy and small business support, empowering them economically.
- v. To provide health education and preventive care services by organizing health camps and awareness programs, improving community health outcomes.
- w. To support initiatives for there habilitation of the disabled by providing access to healthcare and vocational training, promoting inclusivity and independence.
- x. To provide legal aid and advocacy for women's rights by offering legal clinics and awareness campaigns, ensuring justice and gender equality.
- y. To support community-based initiatives for environmental protection by engaging local communities in conservation efforts, ensuring sustainable natural resource management.
- z. To provide access to clean water and sanitation facilities by implementing water projects and hygiene education, improving health and sanitation standards.

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- aa. To support initiatives for the preservation of cultural heritage by promoting cultural festivals and heritage sites, preserving cultural identity and history.
- bb. To provide training in disaster preparedness and response by conducting drills and workshops, ensuring community resilience and safety.
- cc. To support initiatives for the empowerment of marginalized communities by advocating for their rights and providing access to resources, promoting inclusivity and social justice.
- dd.To provide support for victims of domestic violence and abuse by offering shelter and counseling services, ensuring safety and empowerment.
- ee. To support initiatives for the conservation of biodiversity by promoting wildlife protection and sustainable land use, preserving ecosystems and biodiversity.
- ff. To provide access to affordable housing for the homeless by constructing low- cost housing and providing rental assistance, ensuring shelter and dignity.
- gg.To support initiatives for the protection of animal rights by advocating for animal welfare laws and supporting animal shelters, promoting compassion and respect for animals.
- hh. To collaborate with healthcare professionals to provide mental health services in rural areas, addressing the unmet mental health needs of under served populations.
- ii. To promote digital literacy among women and girls in rural areas, equipping them with essential skills for the digital age and enhancing their access to information and opportunities.
- jj. To organize works hops and seminars on environmental sustain ability and climate change mitigation, raising awareness and inspiring action for a greener planet.
- kk. To collaborate with government agencies and NGOs to advocate for the rights of marginalized youth, amplifying their voices and championing their cause.

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- II. To advocate for policies and programs that promote social inclusion, dignity, and quality of life for elderly people, safeguarding their well-being and honoring their contributions to society.
- mm. To accept donations, grants and other gifts and deal with the same for the trust.
- nn. To invest in disaster preparedness and relief efforts, such as building disaster- resistant infrastructure and providing aid and relief services in the event of natural disasters.
 - 00. To establish a network of volunteers and professionals dedicated to the mission of the charitable trust.
 - pp. To acquire movable and immovable properties by purchase, lease, hire, exchangeor otherwise and to put down, erect, alter and maintain buildings for the trust's activities.
 - qq. To invest the trust Funds or deal with the same as the trustees may deem it, to carry on the objects of the Trust effectively.
 - rr. To form various committees from time to time which may include the trustees and non - trustees to carry out the above-said Objectives, which will function under the guidelines of the Board of Trustees. The Managing Trustee shall be the Chairman of all the committees.
 - ss. To facilitate public access to Tamil Nadu Government and Central Government schemes through the Social Welfare Department, while actively combating issues such as child marriage and violence against children.
 - tt. The income and funds of the trust shall be utilized for charitable purposes, its institutions, to carry out the objects of the trust and for the development of assets and properties of the trust. And no portion of it would be distributed in any manner to the members of the Board of Trustees.

2. ACTIVITIES

The activities shall be confined to the union of India. The activities would be purely charitable not motivated by profit.

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3. TRUSTFUND

- a) The author of the Trust declares that the sum of Rs. 1000/-(Rupees One Thousand only) that has been dedicated for public charitable purposes and objects of general public utility described above, the receipt of which the TRUSTEES have acknowledged and that the trustes shall and will stand possessed of the said sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) each upon trust and also any other properties, movable or immovable which the trustees may from time to time receivefor augmenting the Trust Fund or for a specified purpose connected with objects of the trust not calculated impede the due working of the trust arising from donations, bequests, gifts, legacies or grants in cash or kind or from any other source whatsoever and also of any investments for the time being representing the same(hereinafter called the trust fund) and also of the net income from the Trust Fund into Trust, and to apply both the income and the capital of the Trust funds of the purposes of the trust.
- b) The first board of trustees of the trust shall hold office for a life time or until they resign. On the death or resignation of any of the above trustees, the remaining trustees may continue to act or at their option, co-opt any person/ persons to the Board of Trustees.
- c) The Managing Trustee maydecide on any matter either at the Board meeting or by the circulation of papers. The quorum for a meeting of the Trustees shall be two persons.
- d) The Managing Trustee shall manage the affairs of the trust on behalf of the Trustees and shall be the person to sue or be sued on behalf of the Trust.

POWERS OF TRUSTEES

Without prejudice to the General Powers of the trustees to manage the Trust, the Trustee shall have the following powers for the management and administration of the Trust and the execution of the objects of the Trust.

a. To keep the trust properties or apply the Trust funds for the acquisition of any kind of property or assets including movable, immovable, actionable claims, securities or any other form of property. At present there are theither 195736 nor immovable

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properties belonging to the trust of its own.

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- b. To open one or more bank accounts in the name and for the Trust anywhere in India, the Founder cum Managing Trustee and Treasurer shall operate the bank accounts jointly.
- c. To invest funds of the trust in any movable or immovable property in any part of the country (India) and further will have the power to sell or vary such investments according to their discretion from time to time. All such investments shall however be only by and in such form and modes as may be prescribed under section 11 (5) read with sec. 13(1)(d) of the Income-tax Act,1961 or from time to time as applicable to Charitable Trusts.
- d. The Managing Trustee shall maintain or cause to maintain a proper book of account of the trust's money, properties, income and expenditure which shall be audited annually by a Chartered Accountant duly appointed for the purpose.
- e. The Trustees shall have the power to collect rent, the interest of other income and invest in the Trust fund and vary such investment from time to time and sell or realize the investment for the Trust by sub-clause (c) clause 5 of section 11. However, the Trustees shall have limited powers to mortgage, raise loans or otherwise alienate the immovable properties, if any of the trust, unless and until necessary or occasion compels such a sale, transfer or encumbrance, or other alienation of the immovable properties. In any such event, the Managing Trustee shall be competent to sell, encumber or otherwise alienate the properties of the trust.
- f. To do all such acts and things as are necessaryfor the control and management of the affairs of the Trust and the purpose of attainment of the objects of the Trust.
- g. To settle, compromise or compound all or any of the debts, Claims, Outstanding amounts, disputes, demands, actions, suits and proceedings, whatsoever by or against in anymanner relating to the Trust or refer the same to arbitration.
- h. To lend or invest the surplus funds of the Trust in such manner as may be decided by the Board of Trustees as specified in section 11 (5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- To incur all such expenses as are necessary for the execution of the Trust and powers under these presents.

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- j. To raise donations or accept gifts or contributions in cash or kind.
- k. To appoint auditors to audit the accounts of the Trust.
- To appoint legal advisors for the Trust.
- m. To appoint such staff as may be necessary for the due administration of the Trust on such remuneration, commission or salary as the Trustees may think proper and suspend remove or replace them whenever necessary.
- n. To reimburse the Trustees towards the pocket expenses which maybe incurred by themin the course of or about the affairs of the trust.
- o. To receive, donations, Contributions, Gifts, Bequests, Legacies and endowments from individuals, charitable or other trusts or institutions for the objects of the trust on such terms and conditions as may be accepted by the Trustees.
- p. To make, alter, or rescind anyrules or regulations regarding the conduct of affairs in respect of which any power or duty is vested in them for the effective management and administration of the Trust.
- q. The funds of the Trust would be utilized only towards the objects and no portion of it would be distributed in any manner to the trustees or persons defined in sec. 13 (1)(c) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

5. VACANCY NOT TO INVALIDATE THE PROCEEDINGS

- a. Any vacancy in the Trustees and/or any illegality in the appointment of TRUSTEES or their proceedings shall not invalidate any prior act or decision of the Managing Trustee.
- b. The Founder cum Managing Trustee shall serve in their position for the duration of their lifetime and possess complete authority to dismiss any trustee from the office in the event of a violation of the Trust's interests.

6. ADMINISTRATION

The Managing Trustee shall have all the powers vested in the Board of Trustees and shall act on behalf of the Board of Trustees subject to the overall control and superintendence of the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees shall have authority to administer

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the trust, its properties and affairs and to do all acts, deeds and things which are calculated to fulfil the performances for the TRUST is established. The Board of Trustees shall act through the Managing Trustee.

7. PROCEEDINGSOFTHETRUSTEES

The Trustees may meet as often as necessary for the Trust's efficient conduct. The TRUSTEES may make decisions on any matter either at their meetings or by the circulation of resolutions or papers. If any of the Trustees are absent in 3 consecutive Board meetings without a prior leave or absence sanctioned by the Board, he shall be deemed to have vacated his office.

8. VOTING

Each Trustee shall have one vote. The opinion of the majority of the Trustees present at a meeting shall be final with respect to all matters relating to the trust.

9. MINUTES.ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:

The Trustees shall maintain true and correct accounts of The Trust a correct record of their deliberation and get the accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

10. NET INCOME OF THE TRUST:

The Trustees shall invest and recover the income of the TRUST FUND and shall provide for all costs, charges, incidental expenses including Insurance premium expenses or ordinary repairs etc., and all other outgoing expenses for the management and administration of the Trust.

11. CREATION OF RESERVES:

The Trustees shall set a part and credit to the depreciation, sinking of other funds, such percentage, portion, or whole of the income of the Trust Fund as may from time to time be determined, by the TRUSTEES. However, as and when the balance standing to the credit of such exceeds the minimum amount which, the trustee may from time to time consider sufficient, it shall be lawful for the Trustees or transfer such surplus amount to the General Fund and apply it in the same manner as the Net Income of the Trust Fund.

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12. APPLICATION OF INCOME AND TRUST FUND:

The Trustees shall, after providing for the same aforesaid payments and disbursements and after setting apart any sum for sinking Fund, reserves etc., apply and utilize the Net Income or the corpus of the Trust, or the Trust fund for the fulfilment of all or any of the public charitable purposes or objects of General public utility referred to in para 2 supra by such ways and means as the Trustees may from time to time in their absolute and unfettered discretion determine.

13. TRUSTEES AND THEIR RELATIVES NOT TO BENEFIT:

Notwithstanding the power vested with the TRUSTEES under the proceeding clauses, no part of the income of the Trust shall ensure directly or indirectly, and no part of the income or property of the Trust shall be used or applied directly or indirectly, for the benefit of the Trustees or any relative of the TRUSTEES or the person who makes a substantial contribution.

14. NO REMUNERATION TO THE TRUSTEES:

The Trustees shall not been titled to draw any remuneration from the Trust.

15. INDEMNITY:

The TRUSTEES shall be kept fully indemnified and harmless by the Trust against any loss or liability arising against them for anything done by them in good faith according to and power and authority conferred on them by these presents.

16. IRREVOCABILITY:

This Trust is irrevocable.

17. OPERATION:

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This Trust shall operate at the State and National level within India.

18. ACCEPTANCE BY TRUSTEES:

The Trustees have agreed to act as Trustees of the Trust subject to all terms, rights, duties and obligations set out in the deed.

19. AMENDMENT:

Any amendment in the Trust deed will be carried out by the procedure laid down under the Indian Trust Act, of 1882.

DISSOLUTION AND ADJUSTMENT OF AFFAIRS;

If the Trust needs to it shall be dissolved as per the provision laid down under the Indian Trust Act, 1882 and the assets at the end shall be donated to a Trust with similar objects and enjoying exemption under sections 12A and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

- 21. The Trust will not carry on any activity to earn profit.
- 22. The benefit of objects would be available to the general public irrespective of caste, creed, religion or sex.
- 23. Alienation of Immovable property shall be done only with prior approval of the Director of Income Tax (Exemptions) Chennai/Commissioner of Income-tax. The Corpus of the Trust is Rs.1000/- and the trust has no other movable & immovable properties at the time of registration.
